## **PIE Student Conduct Code**

As a student participating in the Pinkard Innovative Enterprises Black College Tour, you are expected to engage in responsible behaviors that reflect well upon you, this organization, and your school community; to be civil to one another and to others encountered during this excursion; and to contribute positively to the Black College Tour experience. All facilities, transportation and activity items should be used respectfully and kept in good order at all times.

The following are grounds upon which a student may be disciplined by the PIE Staff and School Staff:

- 1. Willful, material, and substantial disruption or obstruction of any items or activities associated with PIE Black College Tour.
- 2. Participating in an activity that substantially and materially disrupts the normal operations of the PIE Black College Tour or infringes on the rights of members of this excursion.
- 3. Inappropriate behavior: cursing, inappropriate touching, use of alcohol or drugs of any type, vaping or smoking of any type, disrespect of any type, misuse of social media and/or negative postings, conduct that threatens or endangers the health or safety of any person within or related to the PIE Black College Tour, including physical abuse, threats, intimidation, harassment, or sexual misconduct, will not be tolerated.
- 4. Use, possession, manufacture or distribution of illegal drugs or drug-related paraphernalia or the misuse of legal pharmaceutical drugs.
- 5. Use, possession, manufacture or distribution of alcoholic beverages or public intoxication while on PIE Black College Tour.
- 6. Encouraging, permitting, or assisting another to do any act that could subject them to discipline.
- 7. Failure to comply with directions or interference with PIE Staff, School Staff and/or any public safety officer while acting in the performance of his/her duties.
